Discussion was had on the Library Closing policy. Kathy made a motion to accept the policy. Lynette seconded. Motion carried.

Director's report was given by Christinna Swearingen. Had to get a new door counter for one of the downstairs entrances. Library will have a staff work day on the Tuesday, March 25, as Sierra, Pharos, Libby and the MORE catalog will be down due to a server migration. A new high school volunteer and a paid volunteer through SER-SCEP will be starting this month. Working on having open gym nights with other organizations and Embrace is going to be hosting the Storytime Trail for April for SAAM.
